Game Notes: The Moravian University women's basketball squad hosts Drew University here in Johnston Hall this evening in Landmark Conference action. The Hounds are coming off a 64-59 loss at The Catholic University of America last Saturday.

Greyhounds' Backcourt: Senior **Morgan Amy** leads the guards at 5.6 points per game, and she has added 94 assists, 42 rebounds, 26 steals and 12 three-pointers this season. Senior **Ashley Robinson** has contributed 85 points, 46 rebounds, 13 assists, three blocked shots and three steals while freshman **Jayda Cartagena** has posted 39 points, 20 rebounds, 13 assists, two blocked shots and six steals in her debut season. Sophomore **Mikayla Anderson** has 22 points, 20 boards, seven steals, three blocked shots and six assists while junior **Reganne Flannery** has added 22 points, 14 rebounds, 10 assists and six steals. Freshman **Sarah Minter** has 16 points, four steals, three assists and eight rebounds while freshman **Nicole Rendina** has added two points and six boards.

Hounds in the Post: Graduate student **Tessa Zamolyi** leads the team on the boards at 11.6 rebounds per contest to go along with a team-high 15.1 points per game, 40 assists, 26 steals, 10 three-pointers and 13 blocked shots. Graduate student **Kayla Yoegel** is contributing 14.8 points per game to go with 5.2 rebounds per outing, 22 assists, 22 steals, 17 three-pointers and nine blocked shots while junior **Sam Osorio** is contributing 10.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per outing with 22 blocked shots, 20 steals and seven assists on the year. Sophomore **Brielle Guarente** is netting 7.2 points per game with 73 rebounds, 42 assists, 25 steals and nine blocked shots while senior **Emily Markowski** is recording 5.9 points per contest with 67 rebounds, 35 assists, 28 steals, 10 blocked shots and five three-pointers.

Scouting the Rangers: Drew enters the game at 15-4 overall and 5-3 in Landmark Conference action after an 89-32 victory versus Juniata College last Saturday. Senior guard Joey Meyers leads the Rangers with averages of 19.3 points and 8.4 rebounds per game to go along with 66 assists, 40 steals and 27 three-pointers while senior guard Gwen Alberici is netting 8.7 points per contest to go with 89 assists, 49 steals, 48 rebounds and 11 three-pointers. Freshman guard Madelyn Morgan is scoring 8.2 points and grabbing 4.4 rebounds per outing with 30 steals, 29 assists and 14 three-pointers while junior forward Jamie Struble is posting 7.8 points and 5.3 rebounds per game with 33 assists, 27 steals and a team-high 20 blocked shots. Junior forward Gracie Hezel is adding 6.4 points per outing with 71 rebounds, 30 assists, 19 steals and eight blocked shots while senior guard/forward Katrina Wojtowski has 82 points, 50 rebounds, 13 steals, 12 assists,

12 three-pointers and nine blocked shots for Drew. Senior guard Kyra Mann has contributed 65 points, 34 rebounds, 15 assists, 12 steals and 11 three-pointers while freshman guard Ryane Wood has 39 points, nine boards, nine assist and seven three-pointers and freshman forward Gianna Pica has added 40 points, 32 rebounds, six steals, five blocked shots and four assists.

Next Up: The Greyhounds are scheduled to return to action on Saturday, February 4 when the squad hosts Elizabethtown College in a Landmark Conference game tipping off at 2:00 p.m. here in Johnston Hall.
